

EAST KILBRIDE CHESS CLUB CONSTITUTION

Name: East Kilbride Chess Club

Objective: To foster chess in East Kilbride by;

1. Meeting at the club's hired premises and playing chess weekly throughout the season which shall run from August to June (except for public holidays).
2. Being a member of Chess Scotland and affiliated leagues.
3. Running the club by the club committee on a purely voluntary and non-fee basis for the benefit of the club membership.
4. Running an annual tournament, open to chess players from East Kilbride and other chess clubs.
5. Running coaching sessions for juniors and adult beginners by experienced club players with PVG clearance.

Membership: Open to anyone wishing to become a full member of the East Kilbride Chess Club

Club Committee: Made up of the elected posts of President, Secretary, Treasurer, Team Captains and any additional posts decided at the AGM

AGM: To be held within four weeks of either the end of the season or the start of a new season

Club Fees: to be decided at the AGM

AGM Quorum: 8 members

Changes to the constitution: two thirds majority of all members present at AGM required.
